SAFETY & HEALTH at the motor vehicle repair shop follow safe systems of work to ensure that the three elements remain separated FIRE AND EXPLOSIONS Keep the quantity of flammable substances (petrol, cleaning substances etc) to a minimum This reduces fuel for a fire
